



# Technical Assistance to Brownfields Communities Program



The Center for Creative Land Recycling (CCLR or “see-clear”), in collaboration with the Community Brownfields Foundation, has been awarded a five-year grant from the U.S. EPA to be a Technical Assistance to Brownfield (TAB) Communities provider. The intent of the Program is to provide technical assistance to brownfields communities throughout the states and territories of U.S. EPA regions 8, 9, and 10 (Colorado, Montana, North Dakota, South Dakota, Utah, Wyoming, Arizona, California, Hawaii, Nevada, Arkansas, Idaho, Oregon, Washington, American Samoa and Guam). As a TAB provider, our mission is to guide communities through particular brownfields-related processes and to assist them in navigating complex brownfields-related subject matter.

Our team will provide assistance to brownfields communities in the following four formats:

1. **Resource Center:** A web- and phone-based Resource Center to provide contacts, links, case studies, library resources, and other pertinent information to brownfields communities stakeholders.
2. **Custom Trainings:** Tailor-made trainings offered to stakeholders interested in brownfield redevelopment, in order to provide communities with the education and specific tools necessary to identify and address brownfield challenges within their communities.
3. **Technical Assistance:** Technical assistance to stakeholders with limited resources throughout urban and rural areas in order to expand the capacity of brownfields communities to successfully address brownfield challenges within their communities.
4. **Special Initiatives:** Direct outreach and technical assistance to brownfields community stakeholders targeted by existing regional and federal programs or projects for which the need for resources exceeds the current levels available, thus increasing the breadth and diversity of brownfield community stakeholders benefiting from the initiatives’ services.
